☐ upholding the welfare of all horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
☐ requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
acrossing that owners, trainers and exhibitors, or their agents, use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of
their own horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
□ providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care
professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of
standard operating procedure;
☐ providing current information on Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare
initiatives;
□ continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
☐ requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry
regulations in all equestrian competition; and
☐ Actively promoting the development of and adherence to competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse.

equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.


#### OTHER YEAR-END AWARDS

#### THE CENTAUR POINT SYSTEM

1st place = 6 pts; 2nd = 4 pts; 3rd = 3 pts; 4th = 2 pts;  $5^{th}$  1 pt. Show Coefficients: GOLD = 3; SILVER= 2; OESS/ESD = 1; TGIF= 1. TOTAL = Placing points x # of entries in class x Show coefficient

#### HOW TO GET TO CENTAUR



#### **STABLING**

- a) Cost is \$55.00 per box stall and \$45.00 per standing stall per show day, or part of a day. (Show day = 6:30 a.m. to 1 hour after show end.) Add \$20 per stall if overnight. (Overnight = from 5:00 pm on. Earlier arrivals than 5:00 pm = a full day. Please indicate time of arrival & departure.
- b) Stalls will be assigned in following order: 1) first choice to any horse arriving the day before; 2) second choice will be in the order received/paid
- c) Initial bedding of straw is included. If you do not want straw bedding let us know 48 hours prior start of show, and the stall will be left bare. You will need to bring your own bedding.
- d) Fees must be paid in advance to reserve space. Stalls are limited. **SEND STABLING FEE ON A SEPARATE CHEQUE.** If a stall is not available, cheque will be returned to competitor. If stabling fee has been added to entry fee cheque, refunds will be as a credit note only.
- e) Stall sharing is not allowed and stall lessee will be billed for any other horses occupying their space during the competition. Stalls will be reserved only after all conditions are met.
- f) SCRATCHES: Half of the stall fee will be credited if scratched minimum of 48 hours before start time of competition.
- g) FEE REFUND: \$10 of the stall fee will be returned to competitor at the end of day if stall and area is left clean (mucking out not necessary). (Instructions will be emailed out)
- h) TACK STALL is available for \$45. Same rules as above apply. Only 3 tack stalls available.

#### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

- 1) **COMPETITION MANAGER** is Shirley Guertin.
- 2) **SEND** entries to Centaur Riding School, 3845 Frank Kenny Road, Navan, Ont., K4B 0C6.
  - Do not send entries by courier. Priority Post (no signature required) is acceptable.
  - If hand-delivering, please place in mailbox at the head of private laneway. Mailbox is labeled "Show Entries". (mailbox looks like a red barn)
  - Faxed entries are accepted <u>WITH</u> an email money transfer.
  - For email transfers, use this address: info@centaurridingschool.com. Security word centaur.
- 3) **CHEQUES** must be made payable to <u>Shirley Guertin</u>. No post-dated cheques. A FEE of \$30.00 will be charged for cheques that are returned from the bank for any reason.
- 4) **COGGINS TEST**: a copy of a current year negative Coggins test must accompany entries.
- 5) **CLOSING DATE:** July 25, or when full. Entries and all fees <u>MUST BE RECEIVED</u> by closing date. Entries are accepted on a first come basis. They will be closed as soon as the day is full.
- 6) **ADMINISTRATION FEE**: A \$40.00 administration fee per entry will be charged. Of this fee \$10.00 will be refunded to the exhibitor if: 1) all fees have been paid; 2) the entry is received by the required date; 3) the entry form is completely filled out with absolutely no missing information, and 4) everything is together in one envelope.. Refunds must be picked up. They will not be mailed out.
- 7) **PHONE/ LATE ENTRIES** may be accepted, provided riding times have not been set up. An additional fee of \$25 will be charged. For such entries, be prepared to pay via an email money transfer. Without payment, the entry will not be accepted.
- 9) **SWAPPING HORSE AND/OR RIDER** into already entered classes will be accepted up to 24 hours prior start of show with a \$30 additional fee. Horse and/or Rider must be up to date on all paperwork.
- 10) **SCRATCHES**: For entries scratched before the closing date, administration fee will be retained and the balance along with all other fees will be returned to exhibitor. Entries scratched more than 5 days before the start of the show will forfeit administration fee and will have 50% of entry fees credited to a later show; entries scratched more than 48 hours before the start of the show will forfeit administration fee and will have 25% of entry fees credited to a later show. Credits allowed provided a vet or medical certificate is in the hands of the show secretary before the end of the show. All other withdrawals of entries are non-refundable. "No-shows" will forfeit all refunds including administration fee. All cancellations must be made in writing.
- 11) **DECISIONS:** Every class offered herein is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current EC Rule Book and will be held and judged in accordance with said rule book. All questions not covered by these rules shall be decided by the Competition Manager, her decision to be final. The Competition Manager further reserves the right to cancel, combine, change any class and to limit entries.
- 12) **TOC** Test of choice. Please indicate on your entry form the test you wish to ride. TOC divisions are considered to be Open category.
- 13) RING SIZE if fewer entries, the Training Level tests may be ridden in the 20x60 ring
- 14) **START TIMES** will be posted at <a href="www.CentaurRidingSchool.com">www.FoxVillage.com</a> by the Thursday prior show. Please do not call for riding times. Classes will not necessarily be run in the sequence on the prize list.
- 15) **HORSE RECORDINGS** entries are required to hold an EC Horse Recording and have paid the annual activation fee to compete. <u>Do not send</u> photocopy of horse recording with entries, information will be verified directly with EC. Please note that FEI Para tests do not require that the horse have a horse recording.
- 16) **DRUG TESTING**: Any horse entered may, while on the show grounds and on the recommendation of the chairman of the provincial Equine Medication Control Committee or the chairman's appointee, be selected for equine medication control testing.
- 17) **EC, PROVINCIAL & DC MEMBERSHIPS**: Owners & riders at Gold Shows must have an EC Gold Level Sport license as well as be a member in their provincial organization. Owners & riders at Silver Shows must have an EC Silver Level Sport license as well as be a member in their provincial

- organization. Riders must also be members of Dressage Canada. Photocopies of above <u>are not necessary</u>, as membership status will be verified directly with EC (help save trees!).
- 18) **EC DRESSAGE LEVY FEE** "All EC sanctioned Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum Dressage competitions collect and remit \$10 per horse entered in the competition to Equestrian Canada. Revenue generated from the Levy is used to support talent identification, personal development and the high performance teams representing Canada at major games". For the 2017 program, go to <a href="https://www.equestrian.ca/sport/dressage/programs">https://www.equestrian.ca/sport/dressage/programs</a>. Competitors entered in PARA classes are exempt from this fee. PARA riders entering the regular EC or FEI classes are required to pay the DC Levy.
- **19) COMMUNICATION** will be done <u>through email only</u>. Please ensure your correct address is added to the entry form, or you may be left out of the loop!
- 20) **PERSON RESPONSIBLE** The Person Responsible (PR) for a horse must be an adult who has, or shares responsibility for the care, training, custody, and /\*performance of the horse and who has official responsibility for that horse under EC Rules. The PR is liable under the penalty provisions of the applicable EC Rules for any rule violations.

Every entry form for an EC sanctioned competition must identify the PR and be signed by the PR. The Person Responsible is ultimately responsible for the condition, fitness and management of the horse and is alone responsible for any act performed by himself/herself or by any other person with authorized access to the horse in the stables, elsewhere on the grounds, or while the horse is being ridden, driven or exercised.

A: For adult entries into EC sanctioned competitions the PR shall be either the trainer, the owner of the horse of the competitor who rides or drives the horse during the EC sanctioned competition.

B: For Junior entries into EC sanctioned competitions the Junior competitor cannot be the PR. For Junior entries the PR may be either the trainer, the owner of the horse, or a parent/guardian of the Junior competitor.


- 21) **HORS CONCOURS** entries will be accepted if there is room.
- 22) Horses that are not entered in the show will not be admitted to the show grounds.
- 23) **MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES** All EC rules such those pertaining to Membership, equine medications control, passports and entry status apply to all miscellaneous classes held at this show.
- 24) **LONGEING** and **RIDING** will be permitted the day before the show in designated areas and arranged times. Longeing on Show Day will not be permitted. (Please see EC Rule Book)
- 25) **SAFETY HEADGEAR** All athletes, regardless of age or level of competition, must wear properly fitted and fastened safety approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at any EC-sanctioned Dressage competition at the event location. (Please see EC Rule Book)
- 26) **COMPETITION NUMBERS** must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise areas as well as in the competition ring.
- 27) **WALK/TROT CLASSES** This class is intended for Green Horses. It is highly recommended that the horses in the Walk/Trot classes be ridden by experienced riders.
- 28) **TENTATIVE SCHEDULE** This show operates with 2 rings for the 20x40m tests and 1 ring for the 20x60m tests. It is impossible to predict the riding times. 20x40m classes will be grouped together, hopefully first thing in the day, followed by remaining classes. Final riding times are dictated by competitors with more than one more horse, and by size of classes to give ample space between rides. Silver and Gold classes may run concurrently.

Do not participate in this EC-sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition."

I understand that the sport of horses is a high risk sport & that I am participating at my own risk & in full knowledge that there is some element of risk that an accident could occur & result in injury or death to the rider or mount.

In consideration of acceptance of this entry or my being permitted to take part in the event, I agree to save harmless & keep indemnified Centaur Riding School Show organizers, and their respective agents, officials, servants & representatives from & against all claims, actions, cost and expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss or damage to any person or property however caused, arising out of or in connection with my taking part in this event & notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by negligence of Shirley Guertin, Michael Cook, their agents, official, servants or representatives. It is understood & agreed that the agreement is to be binding on myself, my heirs & assigns.
