MARCH-2009: From the Board...

Membership Time: This is the last newsletter you will receive if you have not renewed your OADG membership for 2009. The 2009 membership form is attached to this newsletter. Make sure you renew before the start of show season so all your scores will count towards year-end awards.

OADG Local and CADORA Ontario membership cards will be mailed out in Mid April. If you joined Cadora National you will receive a National membership card from CADORA Inc. sometime in April.

Horse Passports: This is a reminder that you should NOT put the originals of membership cards, coggins tests, important papers, money, cheques or other important items inside the front/back cover of your horses' passport. Items slipped into the passport cover are routinely lost when the passport is shuffled from the office to the stewards and back. You should put copies of your relevant membership cards and copies of your horses' coggins test in the passport cover – but not the originals. You should bring the original papers with you to the show in your wallet in case they are requested.

OADG Web Site: Be sure to check out the "Services" page off the main OADG web page. This page lists local area stables, tack stores, horse practitioners in the Ottawa Area. If you would like to have your information listed on this page please contact our webmaster Darlene Grant with the information and she will add it. If you would like your information updated please also contact Darlene. We hope that this page will help those seeking to start or broaden their dressage interests in the Ottawa area by providing a page where local dressage information is available.

CADORA Ontario AGM: The CADORA Ontario Silver Awards will be presented at the CADORA Ontario AGM and banquet on Sunday April 26th 2009 at the RCRA in Newmarket. Full details can be found in the CADORA Ontario Newsletter. Please check the CADORA Ontario web page to determine if you are a Silver Award recipient: <http://www.cadora.ca/Cadhora-Ontario/>, or the winter 2009 edition of the CADORA Ontario newsletter. Note that CADORA Ontario awards will not be mailed in 2009 if you do not attend the banquet. If you are receiving a CADORA Ontario award and are not able to attend the banquet please let Pierre Paquette know so that he can collect the award for you. You will then have to make arrangements with Pierre to retrieve the award later.

If you have something you would like discussed at the CADORA Ontario level please let Pierre Paquette know so he can bring up your topic at the meeting.

Note about PrizeLists: Most show organizers will be posting their prize lists on their respective websites and will NOT be sending prize lists by regular Canada Post Mail. If you require a prize list by regular Canada Post Mail, please contact the show organizer directly to ensure you receive one.

Silver FEI Classes not available at some shows: Some Silver shows have not employed judges with the necessary credentials to judge FEI classes due the cost and availability of the required judges. Please check your prizelists carefully for classes offered. If in doubt contact the show organizer.

Make sure you get a copy and read it over before show season starts so you are not caught off-guard at the first show when the Steward says "you cannot use that" because there have been changes to equipment allowed. The Dressage Canada rules committee has done a great job of simplifying the rules and cleaning up the rule book to make it easier to read. Hans Hollenbach clinic commentary from March 7 and 8th

I think it is safe to say that anyone who knows me would say I am not a patient person. I am even less of a patient rider. I become frustrated quickly and struggle a lot, even becoming too rough for what is needed. I can admit that. That is one of the biggest reasons I was so thrilled with the latest clinic we held at HeronCrest Stables with Hans Hollenbach. His approach was playful and kind with a huge emphasis on getting the horse to relax and be willing. Never pushy or loud he quietly got every rider in the clinic and every horse in the clinic to respond and excel.

The first day was spent stripping away all the excess pieces of our bodies till we learned to sit again, not to grip and drive and pull. With many exercises off the horse and back on the horse, even us old and stiff riders managed and improved. I found my seat again and my horse relaxed and opened up her back till it was magic to ride again. With exercises resembling Centered Riding and Alexander techniques, Hans was able to pull all the things we have seen and learned over the years and finally put it together in this riders mind.

The second day was spent improving the horse and the way we all approached riding and dressage. With our new and improved seats we learned ways to lift the back of the horse and bring up the withers till the horses and ponies literally grew taller. His main emphasis though, was still the seat and how to use it as your main instrument. Lower legs were reduced to hamstrings and for a quick response to more power and not for long squeezing and gripping. Thus the horses relaxed and floated ahead. A simple inhale of breath was all that was needed to stop all the horses, even the stubborn 19 year old appaloosa, who loves to be on the forehand and runaway. Hans will be back April 25 and 26 and auditing spots are available but I suggest to arrive for the first rider as he has quite a good talk at the beginning that is well worth it.

Hans is an engaging, interesting and extremely knowledgeable horse-person. He taught us to look inside the horse physically and understand how they work and what propels them forward, and how we as riders are not to get in the way. Every horse he worked with improved by leaps and bounds. Anyone who has watched my daughter Melissa struggle to get her quarter horse to go forward would be impressed to know that when she applies what she learned she can ditch her stick and spurs, and little Slick just floats ahead of her leg. He is the first coach to agree with me that Slick is a sensitive pony, not a dull one. We are all eagerly awaiting his next visit the end of April. Call and come and audit, it is well worth it.

What's new for Awards in 2009:

Judges requirement has been removed for all circuits/levels.

Stipulation added that only highest score per show is considered (or 2 highest depending on circuit).

OADG membership not required for specific awards highlighted. (PeeWee and Ottawa West Dressage Days.)

Horse World Medals – all scores must be from the same level for all circuits.

Number of shows required for Horse World Medals for Discovery is increased to 4.

Ottawa West Dressage Days Criteria included. (OADG membership not required for these awards)

2009 OADG Award Criteria

For All OADG Awards, the following criteria must be met:

Updates for 2009 are highlighted by **Bold** text.

Owner and Rider of the Horse must be members of the OADG on the date of their first show.

Only Dressage Canada/Equine Canada approved tests are eligible for OADG Awards.

The only exception are the CADORA Walk/Trot tests used for W/T Rider and W/T Horse classes, and the Training Level Freestyle test as there is no Equine Canada freestyle available at this level.

Scores from one circuit (ie. Gold) cannot be counted towards another circuit (ie. Silver), except for the FEI Category.

If more than one judge judges the same ride, the combined score will be used and counted as one score.

Scores from 'Special Request' classes at Discovery Shows will **Not** be counted towards Year End Awards.

Juniors and Adult Amateurs may count scores from Open Classes towards the JR and AA level awards.

(A single score cannot be counted twice – once towards AA, and once towards Open, unless an add-on fee was paid to the organizing show.)

If a Competitor is the year end Champion or Reserve in two Circuits (ie. Training level in both Discovery and Silver), the OADG Year End Award will only be given for the Higher Circuit (in this example Silver).

OADG Year End Awards will consist of Discovery, Silver, Gold and FEI circuits. Any local Bronze level shows will qualify for the Discovery Year-End Awards until such time as we have a local Bronze Year-End circuit.

Forms must be received by the OADG awards Director by the deadline set for the current year.

Specific criteria for each circuit is outlined in the Table below.

A membership in any level of OADG, CADORA Ontario or CADORA National is not required for a rider or horse to compete in dressage competitions, but is required to be eligible for any year-end awards or competition grants sponsored by the OADG, CADORA Ontario or CADORA National.

OTTAWA AREA DRESSAGE GROUP of CADORA 2009 MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

The OADG membership packages are divided by levels identifying total fees required to join either: OADG (local group), CADORA Ontario (COAI), and CADORA National. There is also a level for those residing in Quebec, not having a provincial affiliate and not required to join CADORA Ontario. Each member can choose the membership package that fits their particular preferences.

A membership in any level of OADG, CADORA Ontario or CADORA National is not required for a rider or horse to compete in dressage competitions. However; it is necessary for both the rider and at least one owner of the horse (if different) to be members in order to be eligible for any year-end awards or competition grants sponsored by the OADG, CADORA Ontario or CADORA National.

LOCAL: OADG Local membership ONLY (Senior/Junior)

ONTARIO: OADG Local membership and CADORA ONTARIO membership (Senior/Junior)

NATIONAL: OADG Local membership and CADORA Ontario membership and CADORA National membership (Senior/Junior)

QUEBEC NATIONAL: OADG Local membership and CADORA National membership (Senior/Junior)

Quebec residents competing on the Ontario Trillium/Silver circuit must join CADORA Ontario to be eligible for year-end CADORA Ontario Trillium awards. Quebec residents do have the option of not joining CADORA Ontario if they are not competing on the Ontario Trillium/Silver Circuit.
